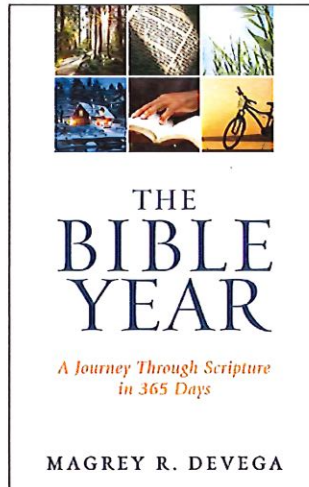

The **Belin Centennial Team** is presenting a monthly historic notes series leading up to our 2025 centennial.

Although the Rev. James Lynch Belin entered the ministry for a "simpler" life, by 1824 he was the owner of a large parcel of land which included Wachesaw Plantation and Cedar Hill, site of the current Belin campus.

The Rev. Belin gave his second cousin, Dr. Allard Belin Flagg, some property overlooking Murrells Inlet as a wedding present. There Dr. Flagg built The Hermitage in 1849, and that relocated structure is today a private home in Murrells Inlet.
