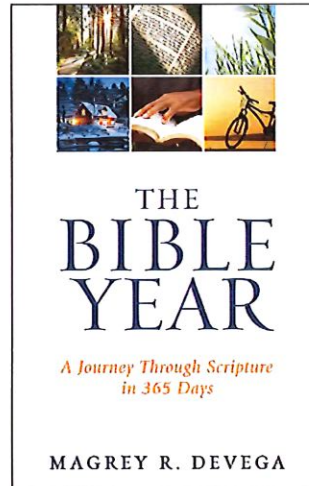

The **Belin Centennial Team** is presenting a monthly historic notes series leading up to our 2025 centennial.

The Rev. James Lynch Belin was ordained as an Elder of the Methodist Episcopal Church, South in 1815. The years following, he ministered to Methodists and residents of all races on the Waccamaw Neck. In 1835, he formally established the Waccamaw Neck Mission. That same year, a church was built at Oatland Plantation; ninety years later that sanctuary would be relocated to Cedar Hill, MurrellsInlet, and be named Belin Memorial Methodist Episcopal Church, South.
